



14th Tinbergen conference – new rules

The Steering Committee of NEPS has decided unanimously in the meeting in Milan held at the 13th Jan Tinbergen European Peace Science Conference to approve some new rules for the 14th Jan Tinbergen Conference to be held on June 23-25, 2014.

- 1) **Multiple submissions.** NEPS members can submit more than one paper to the Network of European Peace Scientists (NEPS) conference. However, in fact, a member can present only a paper. In the submission the presenter must be stated. If the presenter cannot present, the paper is withdrawn from the program.
- 2) **Acceptance and payment** - After the acceptance the authors will have to pay the conference fees on-line by the 30th April. If the authors do not pay the conference fees, the NEPS will assume authors' withdrawing from the conference.
- 3) **Fees.** Conference fees are set to: 80 for senior researchers (NEPS members); 110 euros for senior researchers (non-members), 50 euros for PhD students (NEPS members). 60 euros for PhD students (non-members);
- 4) **Opening of the conference.** The first presentation of the conference will be given by the winner of the NEPS medal of previous year.
